Pythagoras - Christoph Riedweg 2012-03-27

One of the most important mathematical theorems is named after Pythagoras of Samos, but this semi-mythical Greek sage has more to offer than formulas. He is said to have discovered the numerical nature of the basic consonances and transposed the musical proportions to the cosmos, postulating a "harmony of the spheres." He may have coined the words "cosmos" and "philosophy." He is also believed to have taught the doctrine of transmigration of souls and therefore to have advised a vegetarian diet. Ancient legends have Pythagoras conversing with dogs, bears, and bulls. A distinctly Pythagorean way of life, including detailed ritual regulations, was observed by his disciples, who were organized as a secret society. Later, Pythagorean and Platonic teachings became fused. In this Platonized form, Pythagoreanism has remained influential through medieval Christianity and the Renaissance down to the present. Christoph Riedweg's book is an engaging introduction to the fundamental contributions of Pythagoras to the establishment of European culture. To penetrate the intricate maze of lore and ascertain what history can tell us about the philosopher, Riedweg not only

examines the written record but also considers Pythagoras within the cultural, intellectual, and spiritual context of his times. The result is a vivid overview of the life and teachings of a crucial Greek thinker and his most important followers.

Die vorliegende Sammlung von Aufsätzen einiger der weltbesten Spezialisten der antiken griechischen Philosophie konzentriert sich auf die philosophischen Texte, die während der hellenistischen und kaiserlichen Zeit Pythagoras und den Pythagoreern zugeschrieben wurden. Ihre unbekanntes Verfasser behaupten, die Positionen der ursprünglichen pythagoreischen Schule zur Metaphysik, Theologie, Zahlenphilosophie, Physik, Logik, politischen Philosophie, Ethik und zur richtigen Lebensweise zu vermitteln. Die kühnsten unter ihnen präsentieren sich als die Quellen, aus denen Platon und Aristoteles die Inspiration für den Timaios und die Kategorien geschöpft haben. Da sie von den meisten antiken Denkern als maßgebend angesehen wurden, führte dies zu einer Renaissance der platonischen und pythagoreischen Tradition.

Sammlung - Porfirio 1982

De l'oeuvre immense et variée du philosophe Porphyre, il nous reste aujourd'hui une liste et une infime partie de ses textes, des fragments le plus souvent : parmi eux, la Vie de Pythagore et la Lettre à Marcella. La première fait partie de la vaste Histoire de la philosophie, tandis que le second est une consolation écrite par le philosophe à sa femme. Derrière la biographie de l'auteur des Vers d'Or, comme derrière les recommandations du penseur à sa femme, se cachent les grands thèmes de Porphyre, auxquels les détails biographiques ou personnels donnent

une émotion et vérité toutes particulières. Point n'est question dans ces lignes de principes désincarnés, comme il a été souvent reproché au néoplatonisme, mais bien plutôt d'anecdotes savoureuses, dont la valeur métaphorique, voire esotérique, n'ôte rien au charme. Pourquoi être végétarien Mieux vaut jeter au hasard une pierre qu'une parole, telles sont, entre autres, les réflexions pratiques que le lecteur verra abordées. Notre édition rassemble en un volume ces deux brefs opuscules. Chaque texte est précédé d'une notice explicative donnant toutes les informations nécessaires à la bonne intelligence de ces textes aux implications complexes et replace l'œuvre dans la vie du philosophe de Tyr. Les sources, tant explicites qu'implicites, sont analysées en profondeur, de même que les nombreuses hypothèses de lecture que ces textes ont soulevées. Chaque traité est assorti d'un Index Fontium et d'un Index Verborum qui lui est propre; tandis que l'histoire du texte est brièvement relatée. Une bibliographie sommaire est proposée au lecteur soucieux d'approfondir. Des notes éclairent la lecture. L'ouvrage est en outre enrichi par un précieux appendice relatif aux fragments de l'Histoire de la Philosophie.
